Literacy:

FICTION: Traditional tales from a variety of cultures: Required texts:

Hansel and Gretel by Anthony Browne, Walker

Chiln. Will learn to: read & compare Hansel & Gretel and a similar book using drama & story maps; discuss joining sentences using or, and/ but; write witch stories using interesting endings.

Stories involving fantasy: Required texts:

The Dragon Machine by Helen Ward

George and the Dragon by Chris Wormell

The Paper Bag Princess by Robert Munsch

Chiln. create a dragon and write similes to describe it; write dragon stories using conjunctions to write longer sentences.

Instructions: Chiln. will explore features of instructions including bossy verbs. Identify exciting tricky words & discuss how to decode them

Numeracy: During the year children will be taught:

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Science: Exploring Everyday Materials

- To be able to identify a variety of materials and sort them according to a variety of criteria.
- to identify natural and man-made materials.
- To identify that some materials can change shape by squashing, bending, stretching and twisting, and others can't.
- To identify different products that can be made from wood and their features and purposes.
- To identify different materials that are used for the same product.

Humanities: (Geography)

Chiln. will learn to:

- read a simple map or plan.
- identify places using a simple grid system.
- design a map of an island with grid numbers.
- produce instructions for a visitor wanting to visit their imaginary island.
- use geographical vocabulary
- use globes and world maps

Art: Weaving

Use a range of materials. Colour with dyes and water based paints and its effects on different types of materials.

Discuss vocab connected with fabric. Identify simple looms and basic weaving techniques.

P.E: – Gymnastics

The unit aims to encourage children to:

- * remember, repeat and link combinations of gymnastic actions, body shapes and balances with control and precision;
- * recognise and describe what their bodies feel like during different types of activity;
- * improve their work using information they have gained by watching, listening and investigating.
