

Year 1 Curriculum Plan

Autumn Term 1A

Literacy: Stories in familiar settings - Focusing on the story of **Knuffle Bunny** by Mo Willems, children will have many opportunities to practice forming upper and lower case letters as well as using capital letters for names and at the start of sentences. They will then write a story about their favourite toy.

Information texts: Children will understand the structure of non-fiction texts and compare them to fiction texts. Using *The Usborne Book of Big Machines*, children will make up a fantasy vehicle and describe their vehicle using labels and captions.

Numeracy: Counting and sequences: - Count to 100 in ones and tens. Recite, compare and order numbers/objects up to 20
Mental addition and subtraction - understand addition as combining two sets and subtraction as the inverse operation and record addition and subtraction sentences using the method of partitioning. Also, understand a word problem and decide what action is to be taken to solve it.

Money - recognise 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p coins and add two coins using partitioning.

Time - Order days of the week and months of the year. Read and use vocabulary for time (o'clock and half past)


Measures - Estimate, measure and compare objects using uniform stands and non-standard units.

Doubling and halving - Find doubles to 5 and share numbers to 10 identifying which are odd and even.

Religious Studies: Our Wonderful World

Humanities: Weather

In our *Geography* topic, children will understand weather patterns in UK by identifying daily patterns from weather forecasts. They will work as a team to prepare and perform a weather forecast.



Science:

My Body - Children will identify, name and label body parts. They will identify the five senses (sight, touch, smell, taste and sound) and explore what sense we use for different activities.

P.E: Multi-sport circuits (Catching, throwing, balancing, running, jumping, body movements and space awareness).

Arabic: Letter Recognition and Vowels

Art: Colour Creations

Children will identify the primary colours and mix primary colours to create secondary colours. They will create light and dark shades of colour and produce art work based on the work of Kandinsky.

PSHE: Be Yourself

Children will learn to discuss and share their feelings with confidence as to what makes them special, happy and unhappy and different ways of dealing with these.
