

Public Speaking and Debate

Intent

Public Speaking and Debate are both a forgotten art. Children will learn to become confident public-speakers upholding the traditions of the Prophets (pbuh). It will allow children to become more confident in expressing themselves with useful information and wisdom.

Alongside developing their self-confidence, public speaking and debate encourages children to uphold the British Values by distinguishing right from wrong, respecting democracy and democratic processes as well as respecting the civil and criminal law of the country.

Implement

Children have spoken for 1 minute about certain objects. They have identified what makes a good public speaker, while giving each other some constructive advice on how to become better at speaking.

Children will soon be writing arguments for and against a motion which in turn will lead to a debate.
