Literacy:

FICTION: Traditional tales from a variety of cultures: Required texts:

Hansel and Gretel by Anthony Browne, Walker Chltn. Will learn to: read & compare Hansel & Gretel and a similar book using drama & story maps; discuss joining sentences using or, and/ but; write Witch stories using interesting endings

Stories involving fantasy: Required texts:

The Dragon Machine by Helen Ward

George and the Dragon by Chris Wormell

The Paper Bag Princess by Robert Munsch
