# Year 3 Curriculum Plan Autumn Term 1A

#### English:

Stories by the same author: Using the delightful illustrations and books of Roald Dahl, children have many opportunities to practice simple, compound and complex sentences with powerful verbs. They then create their own stories based around Matilda and George's Marvellous Medicine.

<u>Letters</u>: Writing letters using the third person and powerful verbs.

<u>Creating image poetry:</u> Use a selection of poems to explore how to create images using words, **Daddy**Fell into the Pond by Alfred Noyes, The Bug Chant by Tony Mitton, and I Like this Poem by Kaye

Webb. Children find and use adjectives and adjective phrases to convert a poem to prose.

#### Humanities: Land use

Children will take a careful look at the places around them and begin to look for patterns in land use. They will become cartographers, making maps of the local area, and agricultural surveyors by considering where different types of farming activities occur within the UK.

Children will explore what forces are and notice that some forces need contact between two objects. They will be able to identify magnetic materials and investigate uses for magnets.
