

Year 3 Curriculum Plan

Spring Term 2B

English:

Stories about imaginary worlds: Using Fantastic Mr Fox, children familiarise themselves with features of narrative; finding examples from the book & through role play & hot-seating. Focus on direct speech & use the features & format they have seen to plan & write their own fantastic stories!

Recounts: Children will explore The Day I Swapped my Dad for Two Goldfish. Act out swap stories; learn about adverbials & recounts using past tense & 1st person & chronological order. Write a new version of The Diary of a Killer Cat using recount features & complex sentences.

Traditional poems: Children will explore the poems of Robert Louis Stevenson and write a class poem using rhyming couplets. Revise verb tenses and learn about prepositions. Explore the poem Windy Nights and learn it by heart. Produce a class book containing poems written by the children.

Poetry to express emotion: Using Michael Rosen's A to Z, children explore how poetry is used to express emotion.

Computing: Programming

Children will learn to create and debug an algorithm using the move, rotate and repeat commands. They will create algorithms to create shapes and patterns.

Children will learn about William the Conqueror's reign from 1066 onwards, how King John made himself very unpopular as monarch and why King Henry VIII married so many times. Children will also learn about who Queen Anne was, what Queen Victoria achieved during her reign and look at the role of the British monarchy today.

Children will learn about different European artists and attempt to recreate their work.
