# Year 4 Curriculum Plan Autumn Term 1A

#### Literacy:

<u>Stories in Familiar Settings:</u> Explore familiar settings by meeting Horrid Henry and his friends and enemies. Learn about and use adverbs, adverbials and prepositions. Write your own Horrid Henry story!

<u>Information Texts:</u> The children read and map out a text about drums (daf and tabla). They produce a shared text then use this as a model for their own report writing.

<u>Image Poems:</u> Children explore how similes and metaphors can be used to create powerful images, through reading and discussing poems. Photographs, collage and Jeannie Baker's 'Window' inspire children's own poetry.

Numeracy: Place Value: Children will consolidate the concept of place value with numbers of up to four digits. They will explore both expanded and compact methods for addition and subtraction. Finally, they will work on their reasoning skills with one and two-step word problems on addition and subtraction.

<u>Time:</u> Children will learn to tell the time to the nearest minute. They will explore the difference between am and pm and thereafter 12 and 24-hour time. This will lead onto the difference between analogue and digital time. Finally, they will practice their reasoning skills with one and two-step word problems involving time.
