Year 4 Curriculum Plan Summer Term 3B

English:

Fiction with an element of fantasy: Through Morpurgo's touching The Butterfly Lion, children explore fiction with an element of fantasy. Children think about narrator, setting and the impact of language choice. Listening to the majority of the novel, children read selected extracts, discussing and responding to the text. Activities include letter-writing, roleplay, hot-seating the unit culminates with children writing an extra chapter for the novel. Odes and insults: Children investigate the contrasting styles of ode and insult poetry. A range of poetry is included in the resources, the most well-known of which is Shelley's To a Skylark. Simile, metaphor and hyperbole are explored, as children read, discuss, role-play and write on topics including food and birds. The unit ends in a poetry show-down. Which ode will win?
