

Literacy:

Historical Stories –Discuss and analyse features of historical fiction, compiling a glossary of terms. Rehearsing different sentence types and dialogue, punctuation, compare and review books.

Significant Authors: Use Philip Pullman’s Northern Lights to study different types of sentences and expanded noun phrases.

Choral or performance poems - Using a range of poems, identify features of good narrative performance poems. Investigate expanded noun phrases, subjunctive verb forms and figurative language. Also discuss how a range of fairy tales could be re-told as poetry and then write own versions.
